Main Seminar Series in Lima

The [Graduate School](#) of the PUCP will host a workshop and week-long series of seminars through its [Andean Studies Programme](#) on aspects of archaeology and linguistics, based around lectures by the three main UK extended stay participants, Prof. Renfrew and Drs Heggarty and Beresford-Jones of the McDonald Institute. Inaugural lectures will also be given by other senior visiting international scholars such as Prof. Adelaar. Other speakers would include Andean-based academics from both the PUCP itself and other research institutions in Peru, including Dr Alex Chepstow-Lusty of the [Instituto Francés de Estudios Andinos](#) (IFEA), an established European–Andean research institute headquartered in Lima and with branches also in La Paz and Quito.

These events will attract students from other Lima institutions, in particular the relevant departments of the neighbouring [Universidad Nacional Mayor de San Marcos](#). We thereby envisage reaching an audience of some 150 undergraduates, and especially graduates and staff.

Lectures, Seminars and Workshops Outside Lima

After the first week's programme in Lima, Heggarty and Beresford-Jones will leave for a series of further lectures and seminars on themes of the interface between our disciplines in Andean prehistory to be given outside Lima at a range of relevant institutions: the [Centro de Investigación y Promoción del Campesinado](#) in La Paz, [Centro Bartolomé de las Casas](#) in Cuzco, and the universities of Quito (Ecuador), [La Paz](#) and [Cochabamba](#) (Bolivia) and [Cuzco](#) (Peru). This series of seminars will also renew links with organisations working in [bilingual education](#) in Andean languages, both academic institutions (e.g. [PROEIB Andes](#) in Bolivia) and dependencies of national education ministries (e.g. [DINEBIR](#) in Peru).
